



ALICE O. DANIELSEN, *Historian*

Mrs. Danielsen was born in Benson, Minnesota, received her education in the Benson Public Schools, attended the St. Cloud Teachers' College and the Deaconess Hospital of Grand Forks, North Dakota. She did post-graduate work at the Pennsylvania Orthopaedic Institute, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and volunteer work as Visiting Nurse with the Associated Charities of that city and in 1913 she was appointed Visiting Nurse of Grand Forks City. During the World War she did Public Health work in Minot, N. Dak. In 1925 she was appointed Public Health Nurse in the City Schools of Grand Forks and remained there six years and resigned to accept the appointment which she still holds, that of Public Health Nurse of Grand Forks City. She is a charter member of the North Dakota State Nurses Association, and was among the first in the state to enroll in the American Red Cross.
