WAS BORN in Iowa. Attended public schools of Iowa and North Dakota. Graduated from Surrey High School, Surrey, North Dakota. Attended normal schools at Valley City and Minot and graduated from Minot Normal School. Taught in public schools of North Dakota for four years.

Graduated from St. Luke's Hospital and Training School for Nurses at Boise, Idaho. She remained on the staff after graduation. After seven months she came to the Trinity Hospital, Minot. Was Director of the Nursing School for seven years.

Miss Fox took courses in Administration of Nursing Schools, and Supervision in Nursing Schools, at the University of California, Berkeley, California.

In 1930, Miss Fox was appointed Superintendent of Nurses and Principal of the Nursing School of the Good Samaritan Hospital, Nampa, Idaho.

She was Secretary of the North Dakota League of Nursing Education several years and member of the State Board of Nurse Examiners.
