BORN AT Halstad, Minnesota, was educated in the public schools of that place. She graduated from the Grand Forks Deaconess Hospital School for Nurses, Grand Forks, North Dakota, in 1911.

She is a Charter Member of the North Dakota State Nurses Association. Since 1911 she has been employed at the Good Samaritan Hospital School for Nurses, Rugby, North Dakota — the first two years as Assistant Superintendent and Anaesthetist.

In 1918 she joined the American Red Cross Nursing Service. She served as President of the North Dakota State Nurses Association from 1921 to 1922.
