



## ESTHER H. TEICHMANN

*(Ninth President)*

MISS ESTHER TEICHMANN graduated from the Bismarck Evangelical Hospital in 1916. Following her graduation, Miss Teichmann served as office assistant at the Bismarck Hospital until she was called into service in 1918. During this time she was also Secretary of the Red Cross local committee on Nursing Service, assisting in enrolling nurses for active duty during the World War. She held this position until she was assigned to active duty at Camp Dodge, Iowa.

Following her discharge, she did private duty for a short time, after which she took the position of Instructress in her own School of Nursing, where she spent another year. Following this she took a postgraduate course in Public Health at the University of Minnesota; after this she did tuberculosis nursing for a year at Fargo, North Dakota. A survey of the tuberculosis situation was made as the special task. When this service terminated, Miss Teichmann took over the position of City School Nurse at Bismarck, which position she still holds.

Miss Teichmann served as Corresponding Secretary of the State Association for eight and a half years, and three years as its President. She served as a member of the Board of Nurse Examiners for a five-year term, and is at present serving a second five-year term.
